**Report of Student Satisfaction Survey (2020 - 2021)** 

Rabindranath Thakur Mahavidyalaya is a prestigious co-educational institution that believes students form the core of the stakeholders and all the activities undertaken by the institute, hence puts in sincere efforts to fulfill the needs of the students of this college. Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is one of the mandatory criteria set by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) and the college also feels it is necessary to improve the system and hence this survey is carried out to know the strength and improvement areas from the point of view of the students on infrastructure and learning experience.

The survey is conducted and reported by Internal Quality Assessment Cell (IQAC) with support of the Principal and the Heads of all the Departments. The questionnaires were prepared in Google form and circulated to all the departments and then to students. Total 2041 students participated in this online survey in which male students were 57.9% and female students were 42.1%.

The feedback analysis of the SSS highlights our strengths and also indicates our improvement areas.








- 2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?


### 3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




# 4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as




## 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.




6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?




7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.




- 9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.




- 11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.


12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.




13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.




15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.


16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.


17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.




18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.
